I'm sure that together we can agree on how best to approach any such topics.

Here are my expectations:

1. Please provide a lesson plan for my review if there will be class content, discussion, or assignments related to:
 - race
 - gender, gender identity, or LGBTQ-related topics
 - sexuality
 - equity
 - social justice
 - social-emotional learning
2. Please do not ask my child for **[his/her]** preferred pronouns, either verbally or on informational forms; instead, I suggest that you ask the students whether there is anything you should know about how they wish to be addressed
3. As applicable, please remove any signs or symbols of political advocacy or personal preferences from your classroom (e.g., a MAGA hat, a BLM flag, a pride flag, wearing clothing that expresses personal views, classroom posters, etc.).

If you have questions or concerns, please contact me so that we can discuss further. I'm eager to see all of your students succeed, and am looking forward to partnering with you this school year.
